Mercy Housing Northwest's core mission is to create stable, vibrant, and healthy communities by developing, financing, and operating affordable, program-enriched housing for families, seniors, and people with special needs. One of the key differentiators between Mercy Housing Northwest and our affordable housing peers is our Service-Enriched Housing model.
