I often say that “housing is literally our middle name, but it’s not why we do what we do; our mission is to build healthy communities.”

**Health begins at home and in the communities where we live, learn, work, and play.** Leading studies tell us that a person’s zip code contributes more to their health outcomes and longevity than medical care and genetics combined. In fact, up to 80% of a person’s health outcomes are determined by social, environmental, and behavioral factors, commonly referred to as social determinants of health.

People experiencing homelessness and unsafe housing frequently have higher healthcare costs and poorer health outcomes than people who live in communities where they have high quality, affordable homes. But it doesn’t have to be this way.

We partner with residents, healthcare institutions, business and civic leaders, and community groups to build inclusive and equitable communities where all people can attain mental, physical, and social well-being at every stage of their lives.

Together, we can partner with residents in under-resourced communities to build and preserve program-enriched homes that give people the foundation they need to strengthen their communities and lead healthy lives.
